These rules shall govern the event. The judge's decisions in respect of the Vehicle Concours shall be final. Vehicles on the road run will be despatched from the field at minute intervals to avoid any convoy. The public will have access to the display field. Security of an entry vehicle is the responsibility of the owner

The event is open to all veteran, vintage and post vintage motorcars, motorcycles, commercial and military vehicles, and *interesting* post war vehicles up to and including 1993, and all Classic Vehicle Clubs

Veteran vehicles manufactured before 1919
Vintage vehicles manufactured before 1931
Post Vintage vehicles manufactured before 1940
Classic vehicles manufactured before 1993 (Subdivided into three classes by age)

1530	Prize Presentation
1600	Rally disperses. The Centre is open till 1700
